Registration for Fall 2024 Starting the Fall 24 semester, adult education students will be required to attend a testing appointment to enroll in an ESL, Citizenship, or GED class.

Students will fill out an application, take a test for recommended level placement, register for classes, and receive an orientation.

Testing sessions will be offered in-person at the Temecula Valley, Menifee Valley, and San Jacinto Campuses.

Morning and evening sessions will be offered. Morning: 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Evening: 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Testing appointments are now available. Go to our website at: <u>www.msjc.edu/AdultEd</u> and choose one location (campus) and sign up for only one date and time (appointment) per subject.

You are required to stay the duration of the appointment.

*Please note, all students must attend a testing appointment to enroll. Due to program testing, no children are able to attend the appointment.

Steps for Registration Process

<u>Step 1</u>

Sign up on our website to schedule your appointment. Check your email regularly for department updates.

<u>Step 2</u>

New Students: Fill out Adult Education application. Returning Students: Sign in and update Adult Education application information.

<u>Step 3</u>

Come to your appointment to take your required CASAS test for recommended level placement.

- ESL/Citizenship students will take a reading and listening test.
- Citizenship students will take a government test.
- GED students will take a math and English test.

<u>Step 4</u>

Enroll in classes based on your CASAS level.

<u>Step 5</u>

Attend an orientation to learn about program requirements, procedures, and available resources for students.
