Building Opening in the Spring 2025

We are thrilled to announce the opening of the new Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) building at the Menifee Valley Campus in spring 2025. This state-of-the-art, two-story STEM facility promises to significantly enhance students' educational experiences with modern classrooms, labs, and resources dedicated to various STEM disciplines.

The building, funded by Measure AA, encompasses 41,865 Assignable Square Feet (ASF), including 7,931 ASF for lecture rooms and 27,845 ASF for laboratory spaces. It will house general classrooms and specialized labs for biology, physics, astronomy, biotechnology, biology, geology, and chemistry. Additional resources include math labs, general study labs, and faculty offices to support teaching and research activities.

This new STEM building reflects MSJC's commitment to fostering academic excellence and preparing students for careers in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. It will be a hub for innovation and collaboration among students and faculty. We look forward to welcoming students, faculty, and the community to this cutting-edge facility in the spring.

MSJC Celebrates "A Legacy of Transformation" at the 2024 Commencement

This year, 2,183 students earned 2,848 degrees and certificates at the two commencement ceremonies held at Pechanga Resort Casino, marking the highest number of students to date participating in commencement. The ceremonies honored the college district's 60th anniversary with the theme "A Legacy of Transformation."

The commencement ceremony highlighted the journey of Lake Elsinore residents Eric and Carolyn Ellis, husband and wife, who crossed the stage together. Eric, a U.S. Marine Corps veteran with deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan, aspires to become a social worker to support fellow veterans in their mental health journeys.

Carolyn plans to transfer to Loma Linda University to pursue a career as a surgical technician. "MSJC provided all the building blocks we needed to reach our goals and have meaningful careers," Carolyn Ellis said.

MSJC Nursing Program Expands Enrollment to Address a Critical Nursing Shortage

We are pleased to announce a significant expansion of our Nursing program to address California's critical shortage of nurses. Following a rigorous full program review by the California Board of Nursing, authorization was granted on May 23, 2024, to increase the program's annual enrollment from 48 to 72 students, starting in the spring of 2025.

Situated at the Menifee Valley Campus, the Nursing program spans two years, divided into four semesters, and culminates in an Associate of Science in Nursing degree. Graduates are prepared to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN® exam) with an outstanding pass rate exceeding 90% and achieving a perfect 100% pass rate in the last two cohorts.

In addition to the expansion, the MSJC Nursing program recently received accreditation from the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), further elevating its prestige and affirming its commitment to industry quality standards.
