MSJC Celebrates "A Legacy of Transformation" at the 2024 Commencement

This year, 2,183 students earned 2,848 degrees and certificates at the two commencement ceremonies held at Pechanga Resort Casino, marking the highest number of students to date participating in commencement. The ceremonies honored the college district's 60th anniversary with the theme "A Legacy of Transformation."

Joseph Awad, a Temecula resident and MSJC former Student Trustee, was among the two MSJC graduates who received the esteemed Jack Kent Cooke Undergraduate Scholarship. He expressed gratitude to the supportive community at MSJC as he prepares to pursue a major in psychology at the University of California, Los Angeles.

Community College League of California Elects Dr. Roger Schultz as President of the Chief Executives Officers


