MT. SAN JACINTO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT APPLICATION FOR INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Trustees of the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the implementation of the District's Measure AA school facilities bond program.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On November 4, 2014, voters residing within the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District passed Measure AA. Measure AA is a \$295,000,000 bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval; Measure AA was passed by 58.48%.

Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Mt. San Jacinto Community College District Board appoint an Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure AA bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure AA bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure AA; and
- Present to the Board in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure AA bond proceeds.

The Bylaws which govern the Citizens' Oversight Committee are attached to this Application.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board from applications submitted to the District. The Committee shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the Board from a list of candidates submitting written applications, and based on criteria established by Prop 39, to wit:

- One (1) student enrolled and active in a community college support group, such as student government.
- One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District.
- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization.
- Two (2) members active in a bona-fide taxpayers association.
- One (1) member active in a support organization for the college, such as a foundation.
- Three (3) members of the community at-large.

Time Commitment and Term

Initial appointments will be staggered, such that some of the initial appointees will be appointed to serve one full two-year term. The other initial appointments will serve a one-year term, but will be eligible for reappointment by the Board for a second and third two-year term.
