- **Starting the RN-BS as an ADN** demonstrates to employers that you are committed to continuing your nursing education.



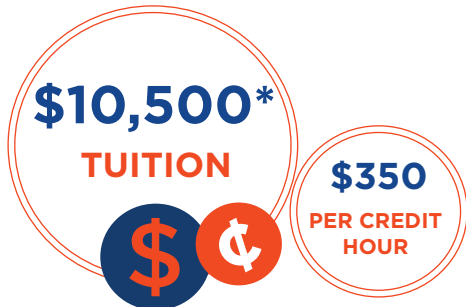

RN-BS APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- I am a nursing student (or a graduate) of an associate degree in nursing program at a **regionally accredited** nursing school or community college.
- I have completed a **3 credit undergraduate statistics course** or intend to enroll in an eligible course during my first semester in the RN-BS program.
- I understand that if I am not a resident of the U.S. that I should email rnbs@boisestate.edu **before** applying.
- I understand that I can start the RN-BS program prior to licensure, but must provide my **RN License Number** to enroll in post-licensure courses required for graduation.

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: If you graduate(d) from a regionally accredited school of nursing with an *associate of science or art*, you will meet Boise State's general education requirements. If you earn(ed) an *associate of applied science or associate of nursing*, or you are a *diploma nurse*, we encourage you to send your transcript(s) to rnbs@boisestate.edu in order to receive a list of any general education courses required by Boise State.

PRE-LICENSURE COURSES: Open to ADN Student

All students must transfer in or take an eligible 3-credit statistics prerequisite during the first semester enrolled in the RN-BS program. The Pre-Licensure courses are eligible for dual enrollment. The remaining courses are not eligible for enrollment until you show proof of an unencumbered RN-license. *Elective courses
