

# Students can get a jumpstart on their BSM

While pursuing an Associate Degree with one of our alliance community colleges you can get a jumpstart on your Bachelor of Science in Management (BSM) degree at the University of Phoenix. Through our alliance with your Community College Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) you can complete the following four upper division courses while finishing your Associate Degree at your college.

- MGT/312 Organizational Behavior for Managers\*
- LDR/300 Innovate Leadership\*
- ETH/321 Ethical and Legal Topics in Business\*
- MGT/362 Change Management and Implementation\*

You will also be eligible for our Tuition Guarantee Program once you complete your Associates Degree and enroll at University of Phoenix which will freeze your tuition at \$350 per credit hour while you complete your BSM program.

# How it works

You enroll in the above classes at University of Phoenix between semesters atyour community college. You may begin after the first, second, or third semester, and depending upon when you start, can complete up to 4 upper division courses.

You will be enrolled in these single courses with other associate degree completers, providing a built-it support system. And upon completion of your associate degree, apply to University of Phoenix and transfer your credits into the BSM program under our current articulation agreement with your community college.
